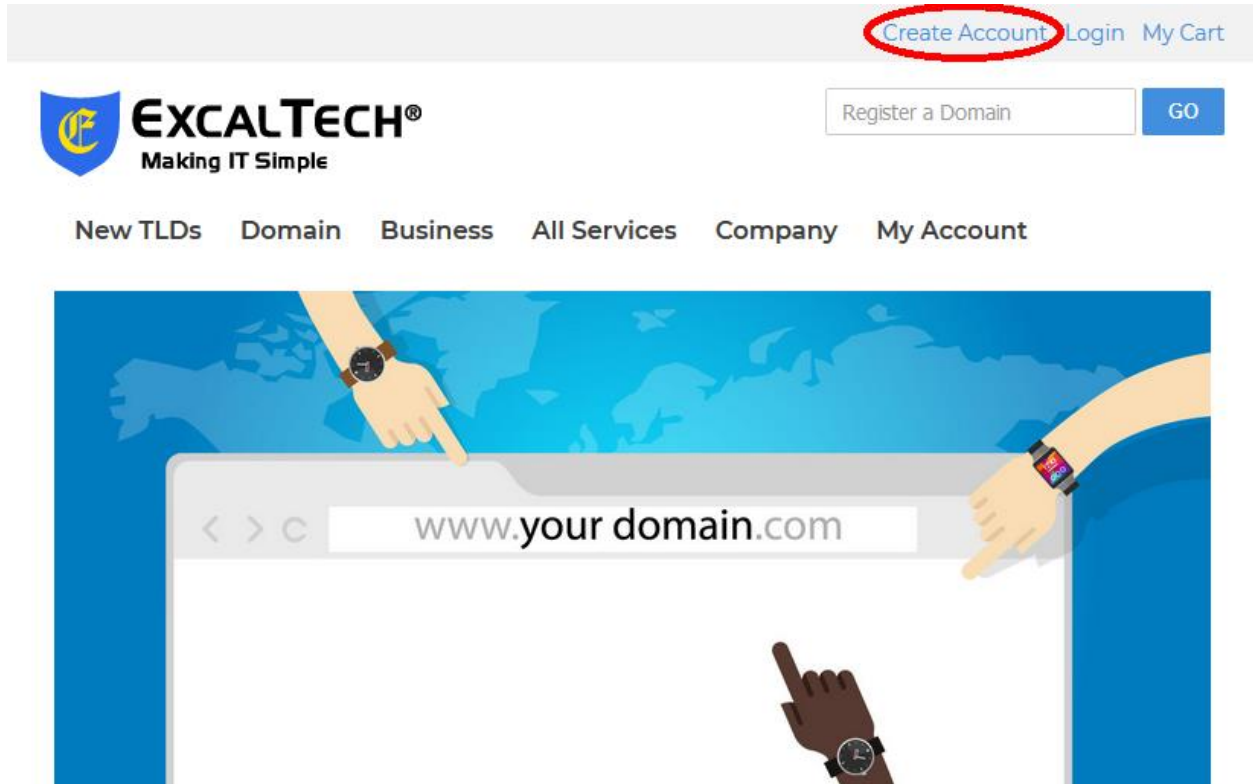


Domain Portal Account Creation Instructions




Fill in all of the fields and click the Create Account button.




