



Domain Transfer Instructions

Prepare Domain for Transfer with Current Registrar

Note: If ExcalTech currently manages your domain name registration with our old domain reseller, and you are simply looking to transfer it to our new reseller portal, please let your Technology Sales Consultant know. We will then handle the steps in this section and send you an authorization code for the transfer, at which point you can skip to the **Initiate Transfer to ExcalTech** section on page 3.

Before you initiate a transfer request in our portal to transfer your domain name registration to ExcalTech, there are a few steps you must take with your current registrar. First, if you are unsure as to who your current domain name registrar is, you will need to perform a WHOIS lookup on your domain name. There are many websites that offer WHOIS lookups, and most of them should work just fine. In this example, we will use GoDaddy's lookup page to view the WHOIS information for our [excaltech.com](http://www.excaltech.com) domain name. Go to <https://www.godaddy.com/whois> in any web browser. Enter the domain name you wish to transfer and click the Search button.

Private registration

In the WHOIS search results, look for a line of text that begins with “**Registrar:**”. This is the line that should tell you who your domain name registrar is.

In this case, the registrar is DBA (doing business as) SRSplus, so SRSplus is the domain's current registrar.

Once you have determined who your domain's current registrar is, login to your domain's portal if you are aware of one. If you are unaware of a portal you can use, you will need to contact the registrar. A quick Google search for the company (in this case, SRSplus) should lead you to their website, where you should be able to find a phone number for contacting them.

There are three actions that must be taken in order to be able to transfer your domain name registration (note that if you do have a portal where you can access your domain and its settings, the exact steps to complete these actions will vary with each registrar's portal):


1. Disable the domain's transfer lock, if it is currently enabled.
2. If the domain has privacy enabled (which hides your contact information from public WHOIS lookups), disable the privacy service.
3. Generate an authorization code – also sometimes referred to as an authorization key, auth code, or EPP code – for the domain, and make note of this code, as you will need to provide it when initiating the transfer request in our portal. **Note:** Some registrars will present this code to you right away, while others will email it to you after a set number of days (most commonly, three days is what we've seen).

After these three actions have been taken, you are ready to initiate the transfer in ExcalTech's domain portal.

Initiate Transfer to ExcalTech

Note: The following instructions are based on the premise that you already have created and set up an account with our domain portal. If you have not already done so, please navigate to <https://www.excaltech.com/help-documentation/> and follow the instructions in our Domain Portal Account Creation Instructions document, which you can access under the Domain Registration Portal heading.

Open the following link in any web browser: <http://excaltech.domains> (you can include “www” as part of the address if you prefer, although it is not required). You then will see the homepage of our domain name registration portal, similar to below. Click the Login link.





Enter your user account credentials in the Login ID and Password fields and click the Login button.

Retrieve the authorization code that was generated for your domain by your current registrar. In the Domains to Transfer text box, enter your domain name, followed by a comma, followed by the authorization code. If you prefer, you can include a space between the comma and the authorization code for readability.

Note: If you plan to transfer more than one domain, you can transfer them at the same time by repeating this process and specifying one domain with authorization code on each line.

You also can click the Modify Domain transfer Settings link if you prefer to review and possibly change any of the default settings (see screenshot on next page). We recommend leaving most of the default settings as they are, with the exception of selecting the Add ID Protect checkbox, which enables the privacy service that hides your contact information from public WHOIS lookups. **This service costs an additional \$10 per year**, but we feel it is well worth it in order to prevent spam bots looking up your contact information and then sending you spam emails.

The next page will ask you to confirm the authorization code(s) you entered in the previous step. If any information looks incorrect, you can make any corrections here. Once everything looks correct, click the Continue button.



Next, your current registrar must release the domain to our system. Typically, this takes 5-7 days to complete. If you have a domain portal with your current registrar, there may be an option in your portal to release the domain immediately. This is not necessary, however, as the domain will be released after 5-7 days.



After your current registrar releases the domain, you will receive an email from **donotreply@name-services.com** with the subject “IMMEDIATE VERIFICATION required for *[domain name]*” (please be sure to check your spam or junk folder in case you do not receive such an email in your inbox). Click the link titled “Click here to verify your email address” to confirm ownership of your email address.

As of January 1, 2014, the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers (ICANN) has mandated that all ICANN accredited registrars begin verifying the WHOIS contact information for all new domain registrations and Registrant contact modifications.

In this example, checking the checkbox for .com means you consent to the sharing of the specified data for domain1.com **and** domain2.com. Checking the “I consent to all of the above” checkbox is effectively the same as checking all the checkboxes in the gray box.

Review all the information in the Registrant Contact area to confirm it is correct. If necessary, update any information that is incorrect, scroll down the page, and click the Save Changes button. There are three other contact types associated with your domain: Administrative Contact, Auxiliary Billing Contact, and Technical Contact. By default, these will all use the contact information you assign to the Registrant Contact. If you have a reason for specifying different contact information for any of these, you can do so on this page as well, although in most cases this is unnecessary.

Note: There will be a checkbox titled “Enable 60-day transfer lock.” above the Save Changes button, and it will be checked by default, which means that upon saving your changes, the domain will not be able to be transferred from ExcalTech to another registrar for the next 60 days. This is a security mechanism that is meant to guard against a potential scenario whereby someone gains unauthorized access to the domain, changes the contact information on the domain to their own information, and then transfers it to an account of their own. We recommend leaving this checked any time you update the WHOIS information on your domain.
